Holly Creek celebrates opening of phase two expansion

CENTENNIAL – Holly Creek Retirement Community held a Fall Harvest Festival, Sept. 25, in celebration of the completion of its phase two expansion. The community, which comprises of several buildings on 17 acres, added 245,000 square feet to its facility in the form of an expanded Town Center offering several new amenities for its residents and apartment homes.

Residents, family, friends and staff filled the Town Center's common areas during the celebration, which included several food tables featuring several gourmet treats prepared by the Holly Creek staff and live music from a jazz trio.

The expanded Town Center now offers Molly's Mercantile, a new general store and gift shop, the Cortez Movie Theater, the fine-dining Centennial Restaurant, a new fellowship hall and a putting green and bocce ball area.

The new movie theater, which will also be used for speaking engagements, lectures and other entertainment, features a large-screen, 35 inclined seats and refreshments. Weekly matinees are offered.

New apartment homes in a building called The Vistas were also celebrated. The 18 luxury apartment homes feature two bedrooms, two baths and a den with more than 1,600 total square feet. The apartments offer stainless

steel appliances, hardwood floors, a gas fireplace, crown molding, upgraded carpeting and granite countertops among other high-end features.
